


The Ulster Museum, the conference venue, stands on the west side of the Belfast Botanic Gardens Park. Begun in 1829 by Belfast Botanic and Horticultural Society, the park was purchased by the Corporation in 1895. It contains the Palm House, one of the earliest surviving examples of curvilinear glass and cast iron. Its wings were built 1839-40 by Richard Turner under the architectural supervision of Charles Lanyon. The central dome was added to a modified design in 1852. After a full restoration the Palm House and the adjacent Tropical Ravine House (1886) were reopened in 1983


